



Skin Hunger: Audience Experience FAQs

Is Skin Hunger Covid-19 safe?

Skin Hunger is a fully Covid-19 secure experience for three audience members at a time, who will always be socially distant from each other. The installation utilizes plastic sheeting, thoroughly disinfected between audience members, to enable intimate encounters between performers & audience whilst keeping everyone safe.

What PPE will I need to wear?

Audience members must wear a mask during the experience; we ask that you bring your own mask with you. If you are medically exempt from wearing a mask, please indicate this in the Order Form, once you've selected your tickets. Plastic gloves will be required for part of the experience & will be provided. Audience members will need to sanitize their hands on entry; hand sanitizer will be available.

Where is the venue?

The hidden chapel is located on Shaftesbury Avenue; the map is [here](#). We will be using the entrance at 136 Shaftesbury Avenue; the wooden door between Wing Stop & Goldwell Academy. The designated queue will be clearly marked outside.

When should I arrive?

Please arrive five minutes before the specified start time. Join the marked queue outside Stone Nest and quote the name on the booking to the Front of House Manager, who will let you in at the start time.

Is the experience seated or standing?

Audience members will be standing throughout the experience and walking through the installation. Please wear flat shoes

Is the experience accessible for wheelchair users?

We unfortunately cannot accommodate electric wheelchairs. We can accommodate manually operated wheelchairs via a temporary ramp; please answer the wheelchair user question on the order form, once you've selected your ticket, and indicate if a Companion will be accompanying you.

Is the experience accessible for Deaf & hard of hearing audience members?

We have provision for BSL interpreted shows on the 19th June; these are bookable via a separate Eventbrite link [here](#). Due to the nature of the performance, we can only accommodate 1 BSL user per entry on the 19th June, so bookings are limited to 1 per transaction.

What is the venue like?

Please be advised that this unique venue has no central heating, so will be cold! No cloakroom or catering facilities will be available; please do not bring large bags with you. Toilets, which will be regularly cleaned, will be available before but not after the show.
